

Youth Games 2021

The Commonwealth Games Federation Executive Board are exploring options for rescheduling the 2021 Commonwealth Youth Games. These were scheduled to take place in August 2021 in Trinidad and Tobago but due to Tokyo Olympic and Paralympic Games being rescheduled to Summer 2021 the Executive Board have decided to reschedule games until 2023 with Trinidad and Tobago being given the first option to host.

Birmingham Games 2022

The first of Performance Planning Meeting for the 2022 Birmingham Games took place in September where representatives of Cycling Ireland High Performance Team and representatives of Cycling Ulster met key members of Team NI including new Chef de Mission Alison Moffitt Robinson. This was a productive meeting informing governing bodies of the timeline and criteria that will be used for athlete selection

The number of athlete places awarded to Northern Ireland is limited and at the behest of CGF and the Birmingham 2022 Organising Committee. For Gold Coast 70 athlete places for Birmingham initial indications are 59 places will be available.

The NICGC will select athletes based upon the following ranked criteria:

1. Potential Birmingham 2022 medallist
2. Potential top 8 position at Birmingham 2022
3. Development athlete, on an upwards trajectory within a NGB performance system, with the potential to obtain a top 8 position at 20226 Commonwealth Games.
