Role Description: Team Coach

Responsibilities:

- Assist with developing selection criteria
- Support relevant parties in identifying a team of riders where required
- Attend team selection/training days/races (as appropriate). Team Coach will also be required to spend approximately four days, including travel time and attendance at the School Games.
- Support the team manager in carrying out their duties pre event and during the event itself
- Provide coaching advice and feedback to the riders
- Create a positive learning and development experience
- Uphold duty of care throughout the event ensuring relevant levels of supervision are achieved
- To read and abide by the event manual, safeguarding plan and role specific code of conduct (where provided)
- Travel with the team as and when required and contribute to the driving to, during and from the event.

- Be a current Cycling Ireland member
- Be Access NI checked through Cycling Ulster
- Have a Cycling Ireland coaching qualification
- Have experience of leading training sessions
- Have a valid driving licence
- Have a good knowledge of the best practices when working with young people
- Must have attended a Safeguarding Course and if necessary completed a refresher course
- Participate in any additional training and/or safeguarding courses as outlined by the School Games organisers.
